Hari Om!!

Greetings from Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Delhi. Normally I write to you at the beginning of the term, however this year I am late due to some unavoidable circumstances. Hope you have enjoyed the summer vacation with your children. Now after a month of school reopening, I think your ward has started taking serious note of Academics, Sports and Co curricular activities

I hope you are aware of the good result of board classes. This year too our students passed their class 10th and 12th exams with flying colours. There is a large number of distinctions in various subjects.

During the summer vacation, a large number of school furniture were repaired. This year we renovated the old block toilets (all three floors) with modern look and now these toilets are more hygienic.

A six days teachers' training programme has been organised for all Vidyalaya teachers to equip them with new ideas and to improve their teaching skills. Swami Anukoolananda ji , Acharya of Chinmaya International Residential School , Coimbatore, came to Delhi and he was kind enough to take two full days workshop for all teachers of Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Delhi. The main input of his workshop was how to implement 'Chinmaya Vision Programme' and how to add values to academic/ non academic subjects.

For security reasons we have issued I.Cards for parents. Without I.Card we are not allowing parents to enter the vidyalaya premises. Please cooperate and do not forget to bring your I.Card for entering the Vidyalaya. You are also requested to make an entry in visitor's register. For students, I.Card is mandatory to wear every day. Also it is mandatory to carry the school almanac.

Good values are the real asset for students as well as for adults. Chinmaya Vidyalaya has always believed in inculcating good values in the children that will benefit them for the rest of their lives. The values inculcated today will have a deep bearing on their later lives. The school has been able to continue with its ethos only with your sustained support and cooperation. I am thankful to you for the same.

I will request you, Parents, to give time to your ward. As the child enters the Adolescent age, he tries to come close to his friends and tries to keep distance from parents. This type of gap between the parent and child is not good. It should be bridged by spending some valuable time with the child. Your child should share everything with you. He/She must have confidence in you and you too must have confidence in your child. Sharing at this age is a key to good understanding.

Parents, without your cooperation it is impossible to run the school. In the past we have received your full cooperation and I expect the same in the coming years.

Besides academics, sports, co curricular activities, discipline, punctuality and following the school rules, play an important role in the personality development of a child. So I take this opportunity to remind you of the following points.

- 1) Please send your child to school latest by 7.50am. School starts at 8.00am. Your child will not be allowed to enter the school if he/she comes after 8.00 am
- Send your child in proper uniform. Your ward's nails should be properly clipped. He/she must carry handkerchief. Boys
 must be sent to Vidyalaya with proper hair cut.
- 3) Make sure your child is not carrying a mobile phone or any other electronic gadget. If found it will be confiscated. It will only be returned after the session ends.
- 4) Make sure your child does not use foul language.
- 5) Your child must take care of school property. Child will be fined heavily if he/she is involved in damaging school property.
- 6) Kindly note that there is no provision of short leave for the students. Please do not send any application for the same or come to school with this request. You are also requested not to send your child to school if he/she is not well. Test/Exam will only be counted if the child is spending the whole day in school.
- 7) While entering the school you are requested to make the entries legitimately in the entry and exit register. It is expected that the guards be given due respect as they are doing their duty for the security of our children.
- 8) Students using bus services shall board and de-board the buses only at the allotted bus stops. Inside the bus your child must sit in a disciplined manner. He/She should not trouble/bully others. If a child is found doing mischief in bus, the school may take action to discontinue his/her bus service.
- 9) You can see me, Vice Principal, Senior Head, Primary Head and Admin Head, with prior appointment or between 9.00am to 10.30 on all working days. You can also mail me in the following mail id a.bose@chinmayavvdelhi.ac.in
