

VISIT TO NATIONAL RAILWAY MUSEUM– (CLASSES III)

LEARNING BEYOND BOOKS

On 27th December, 2017 the students of Grade 3 visited the National Rail Museum situated in Chanakyapuri, New Delhi. The museum focuses on the rail heritage of India. The trip aimed at making the children understand the history and development of the Indian railway system.

Next the students visited the Mini museum which had interesting displays of the parts of trains. **They closely observed the furniture and doors from carriages used in the olden times. Several miniature models of CRANE TANK, Kalka Shimla Rail Bus, Matheran Rail Car No 8899, Fireless Steam Locomotive, Steam Locomotive A -885 HASANG and Steam Locomotive X -37385 etc. fascinated the students.**
