## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

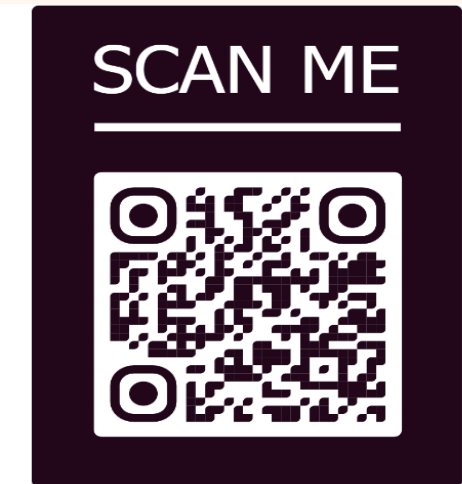

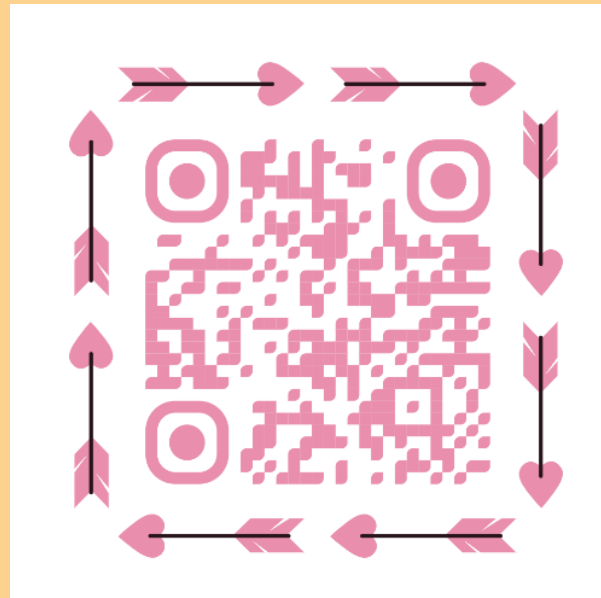

# Bucket Ball Toss

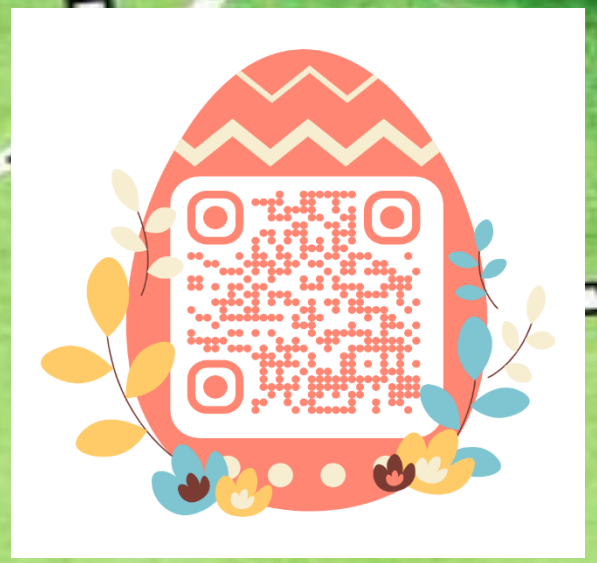
The learners had a great time participating in the Bucket Ball Toss activity, enthusiastically trying to toss the ball into the bucket to earn a reward.

Waiting for you to pass.



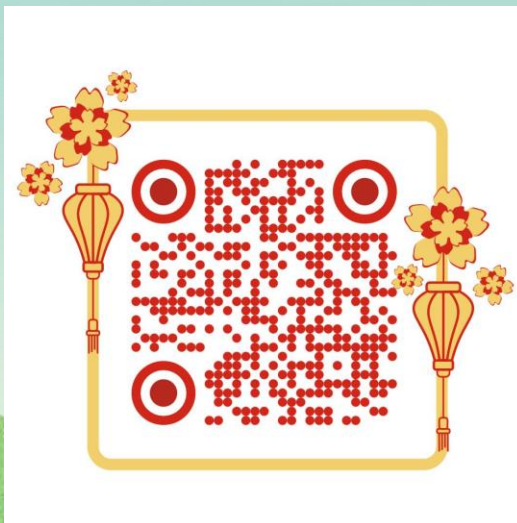
Green is an apple,

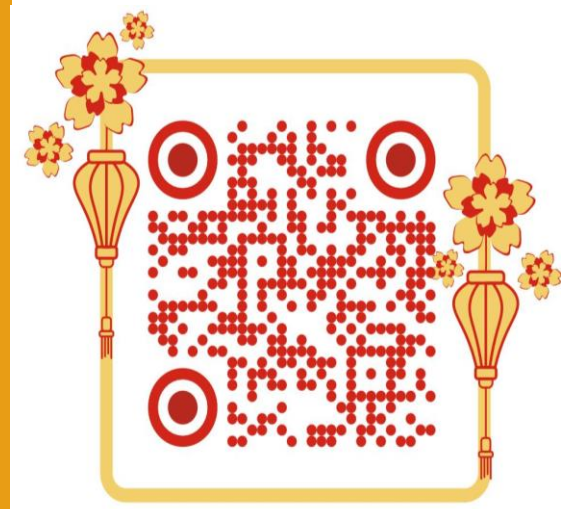
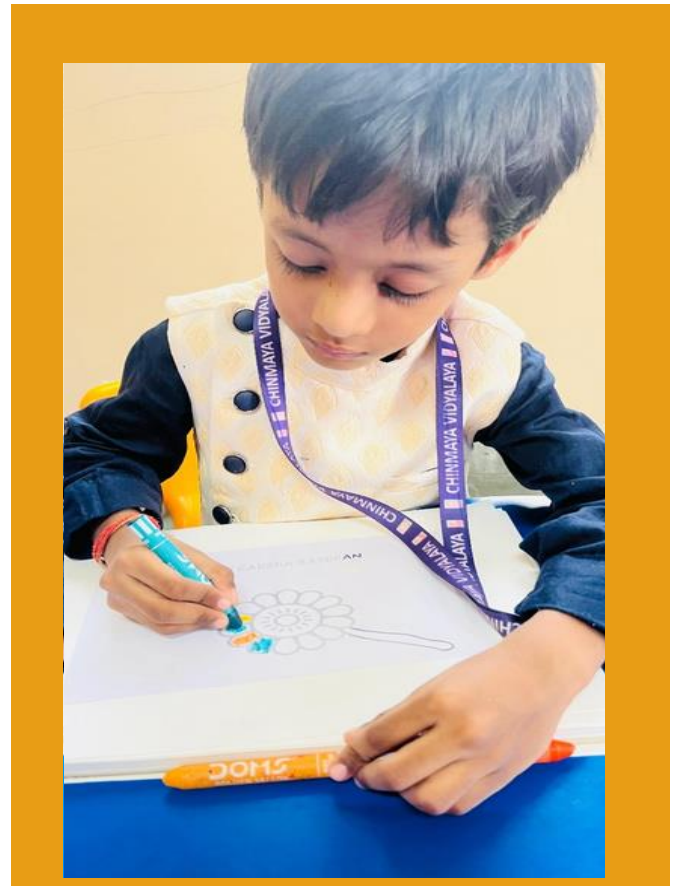

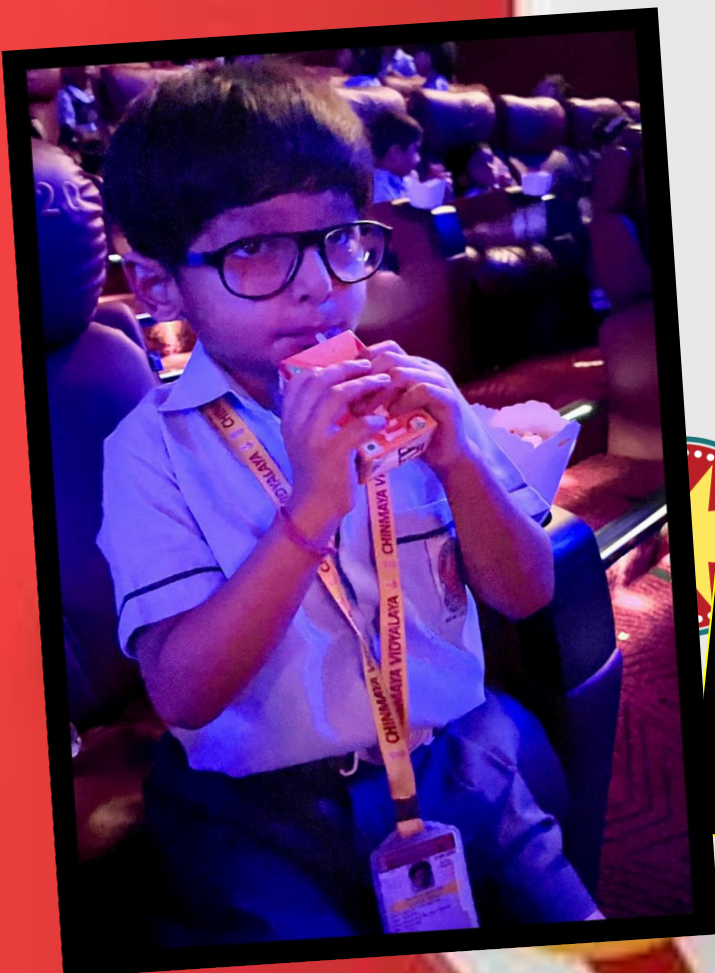




# Cinematic Moments

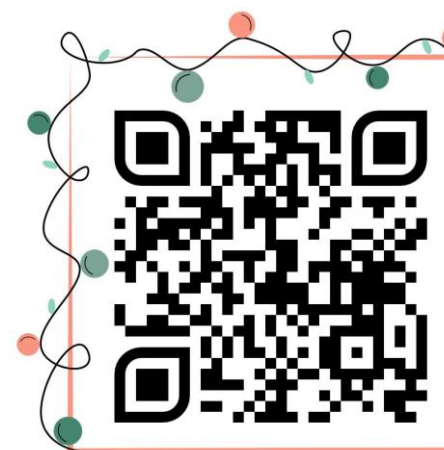


# National Sports Day

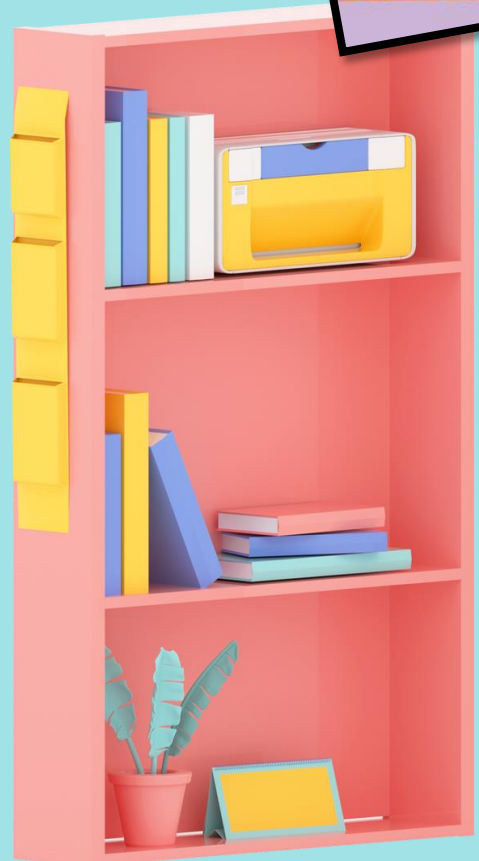

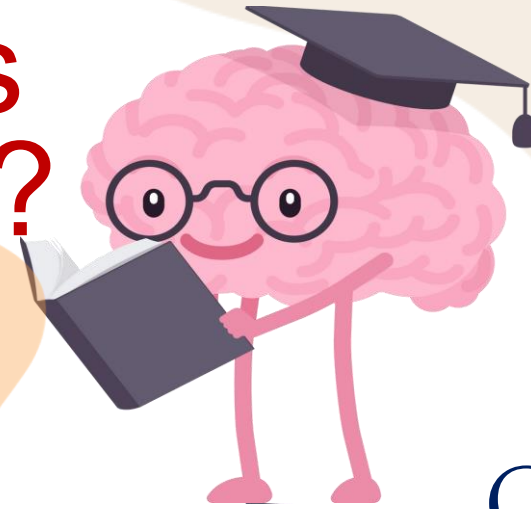
