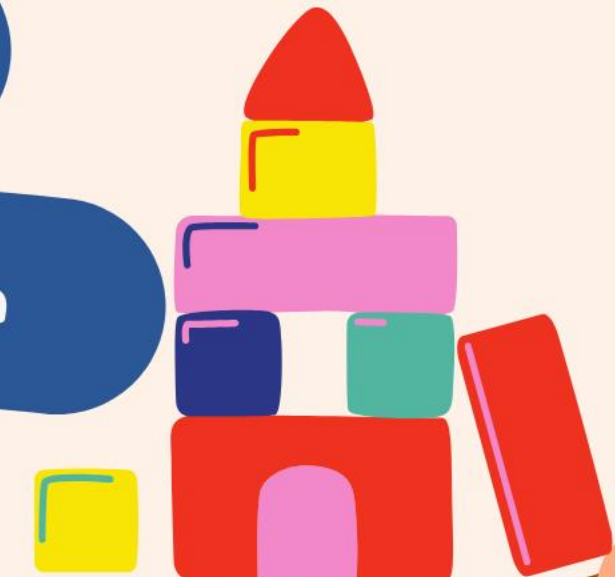

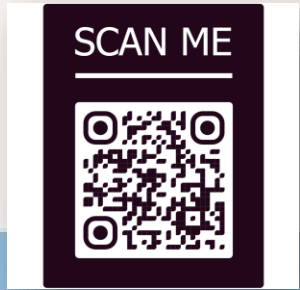
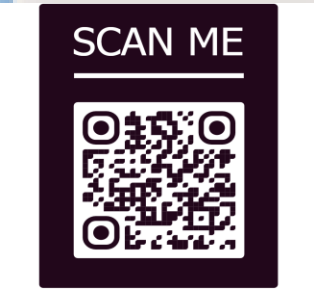

The little learners of Pre-Primary enjoyed a variety of delightful activities, such as Scribbling with Water paint and Hoopla activity.

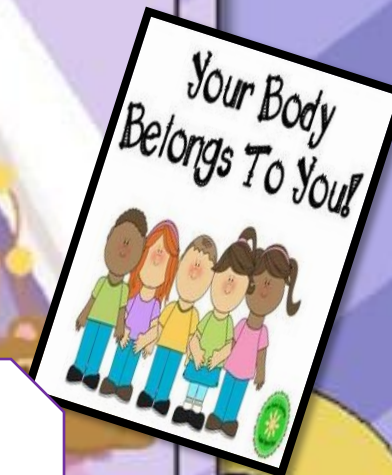
PUPPET SHOW

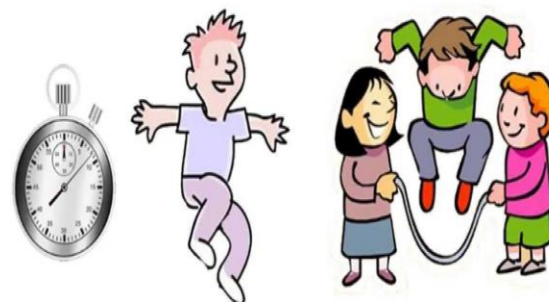
