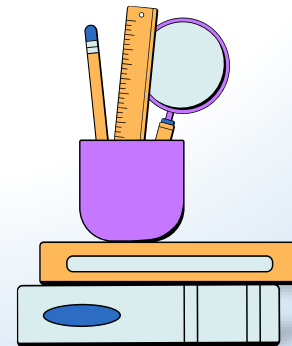

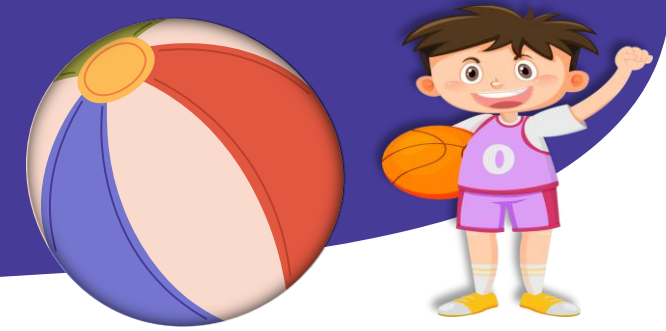


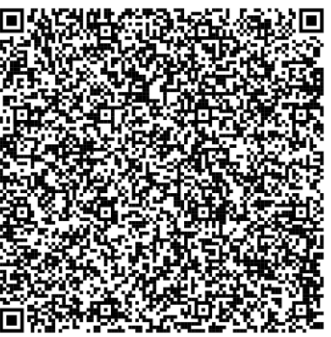
# SENSORIAL ACTIVITY

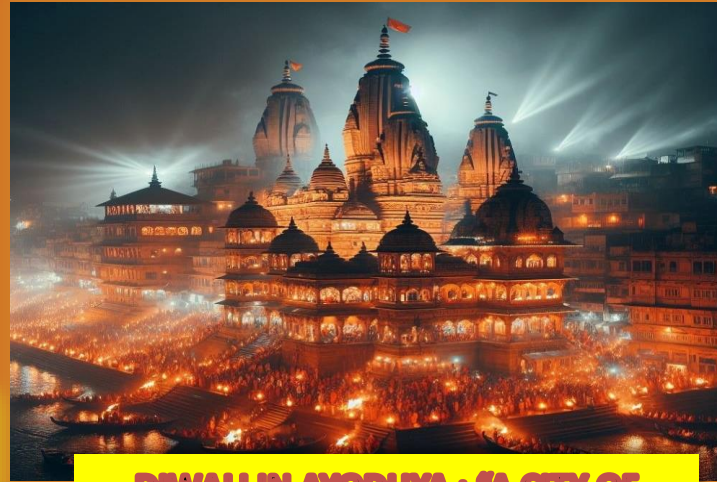

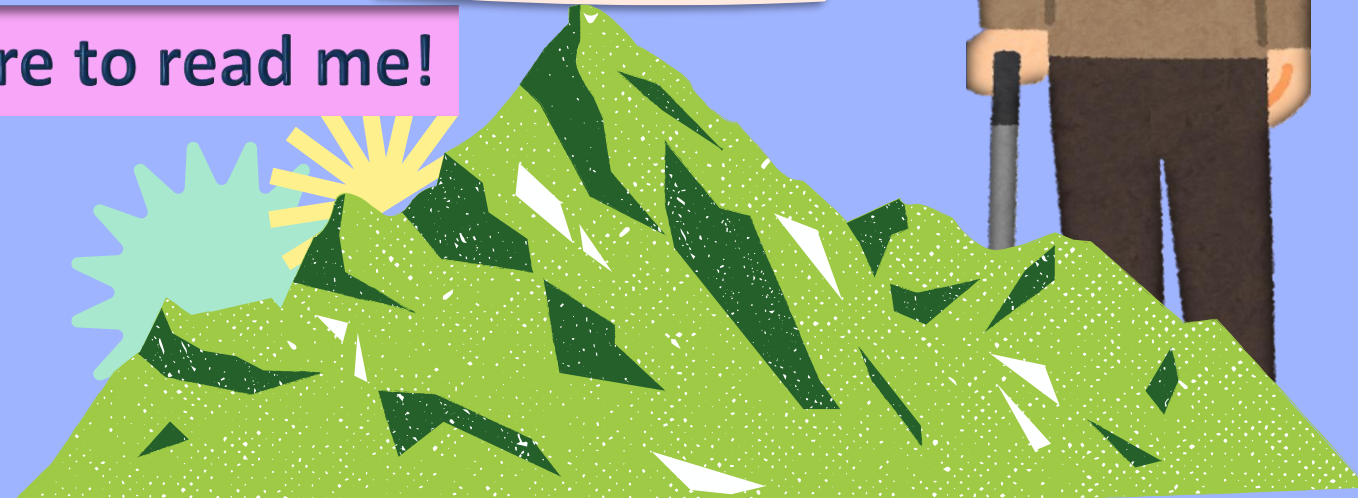

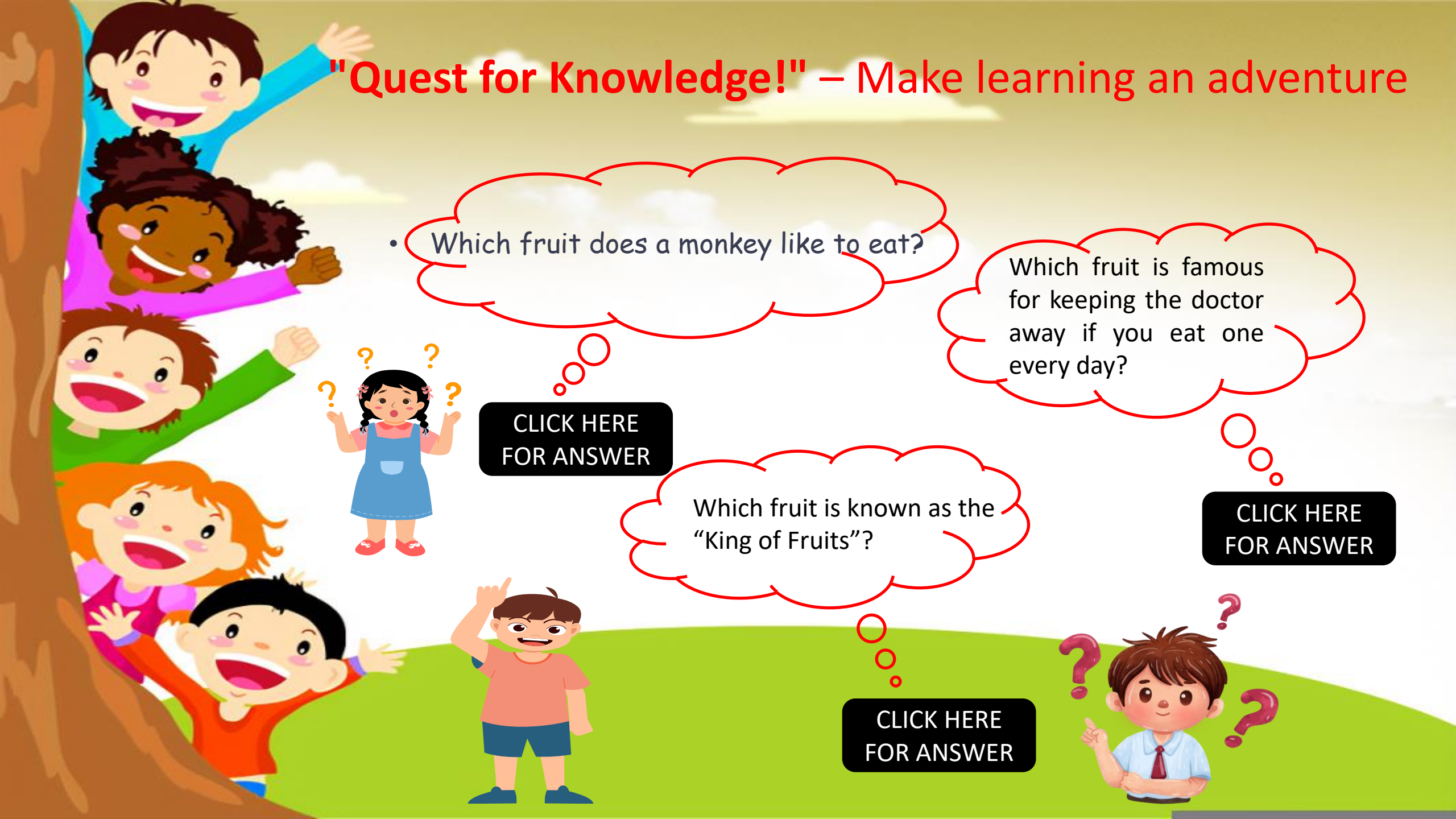
