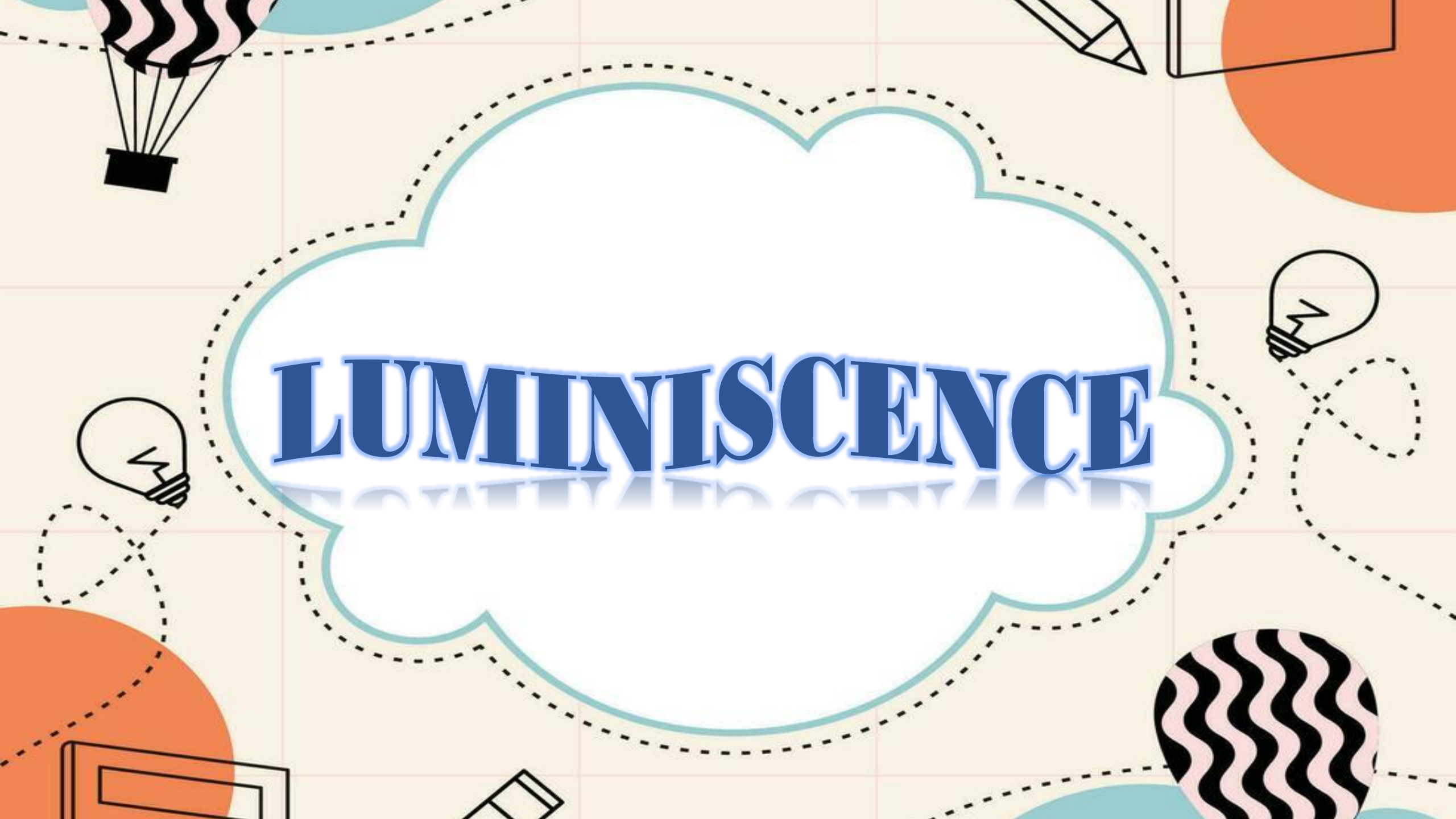

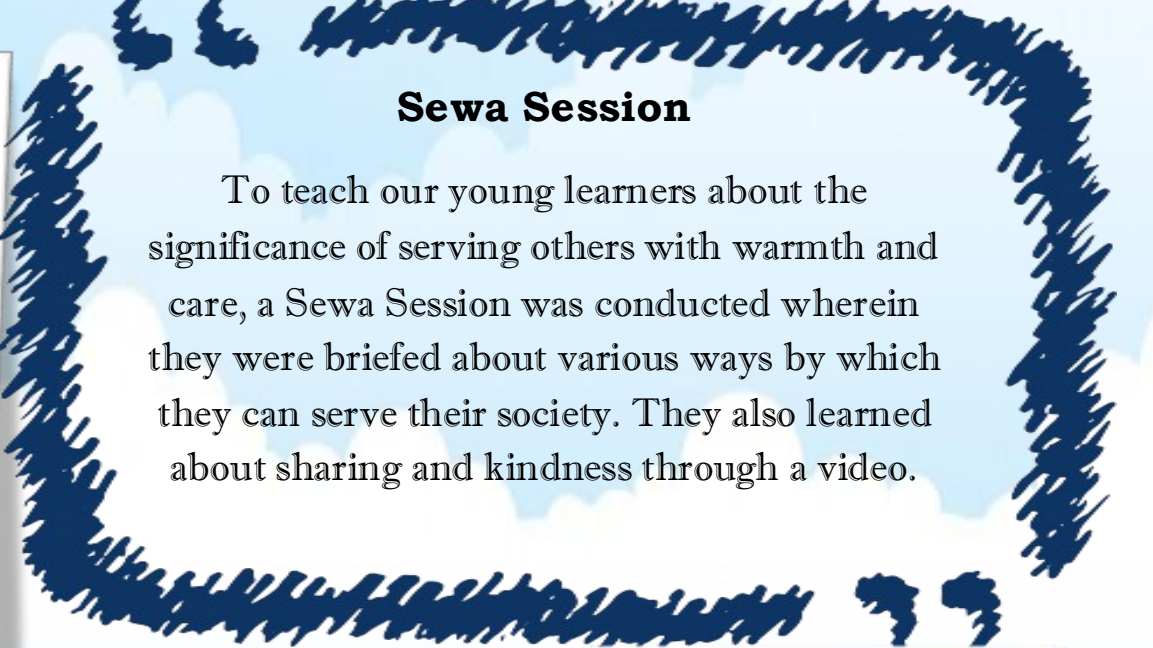
Fitness Frenzy

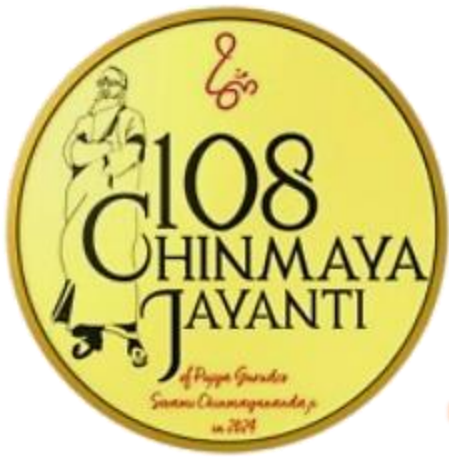


MAY HIGHLIGHTS

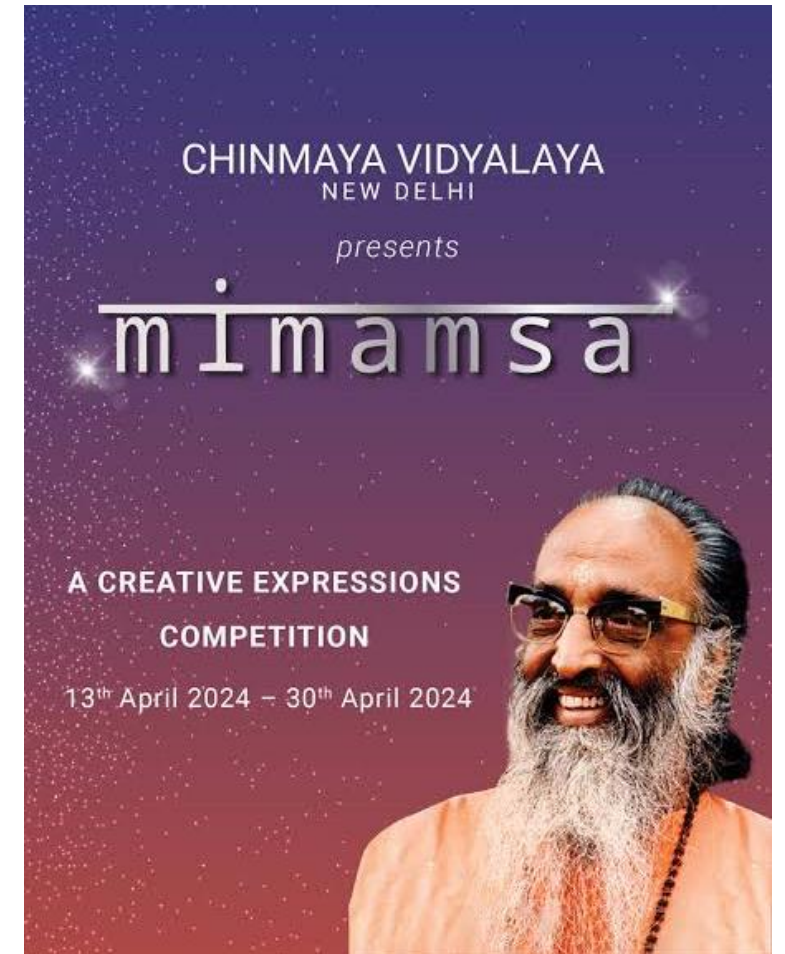

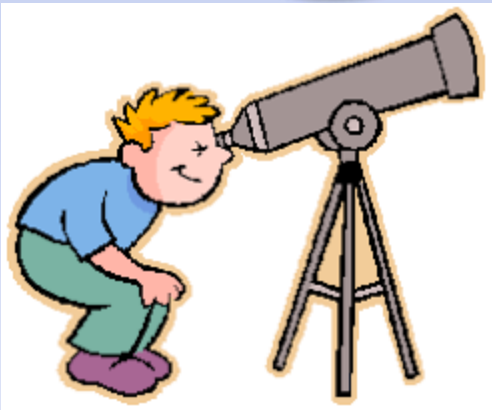

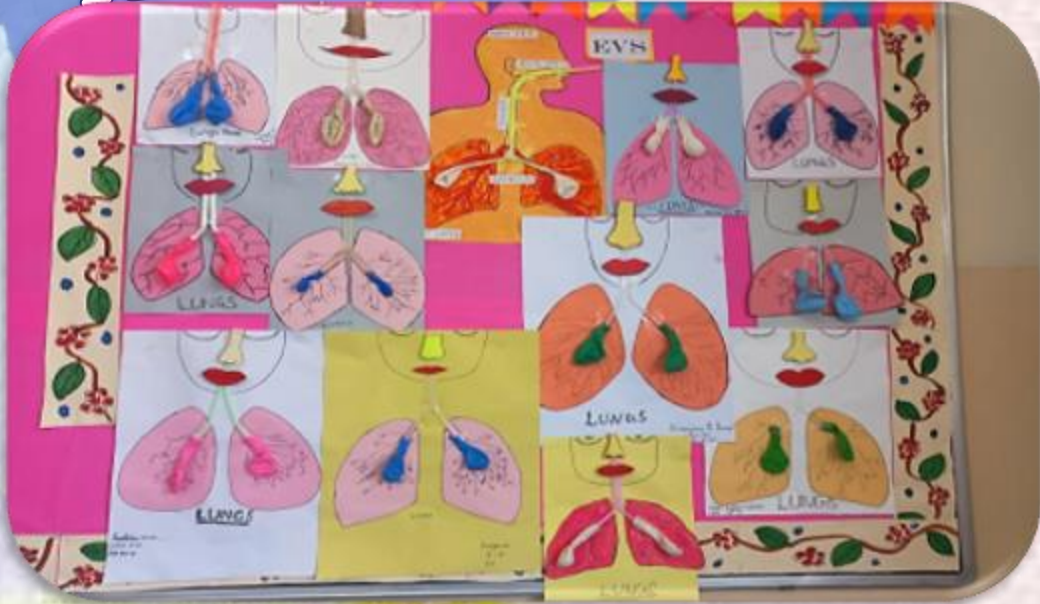
CONGRATS
