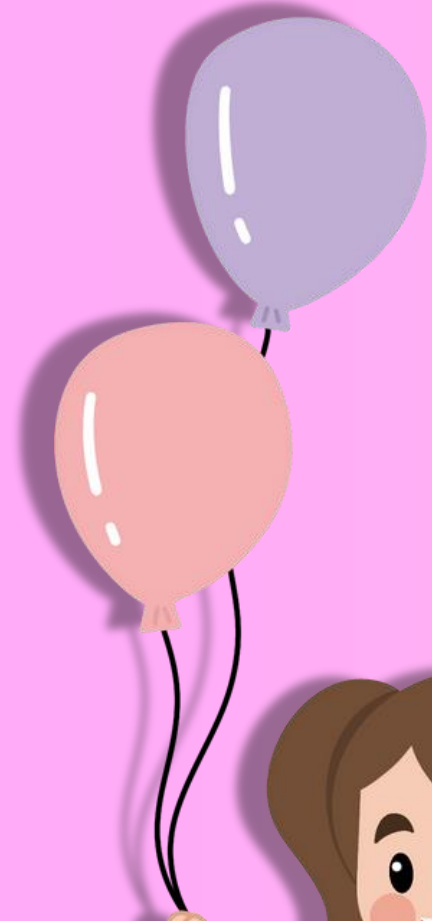

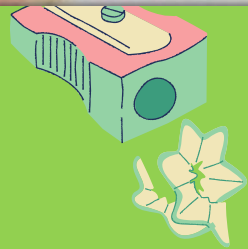


FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

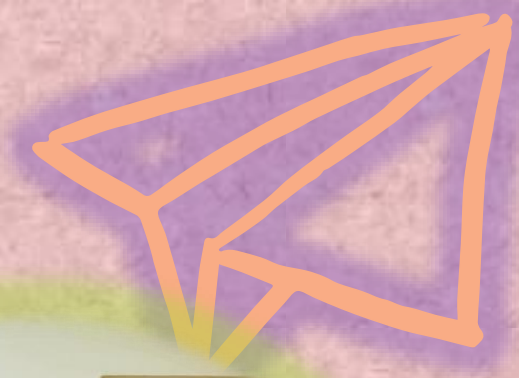

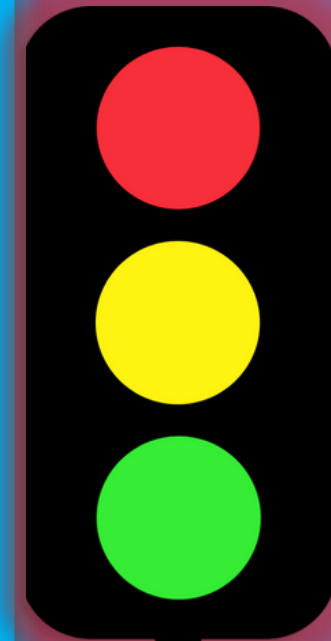


Road Safety

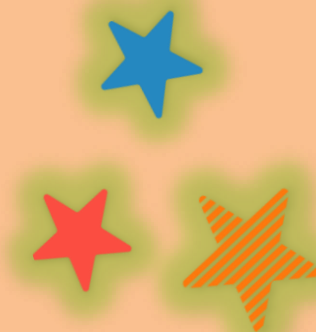
Children's Day

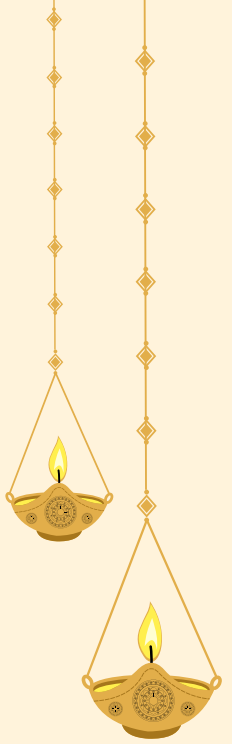

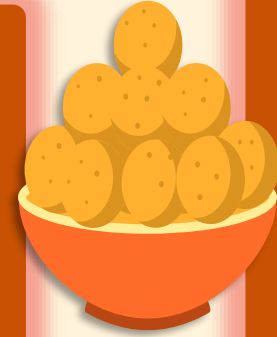




GURUPURAB



Celebrating Gurupurab at the Pre-Primary level is a meaningful and engaging experience.

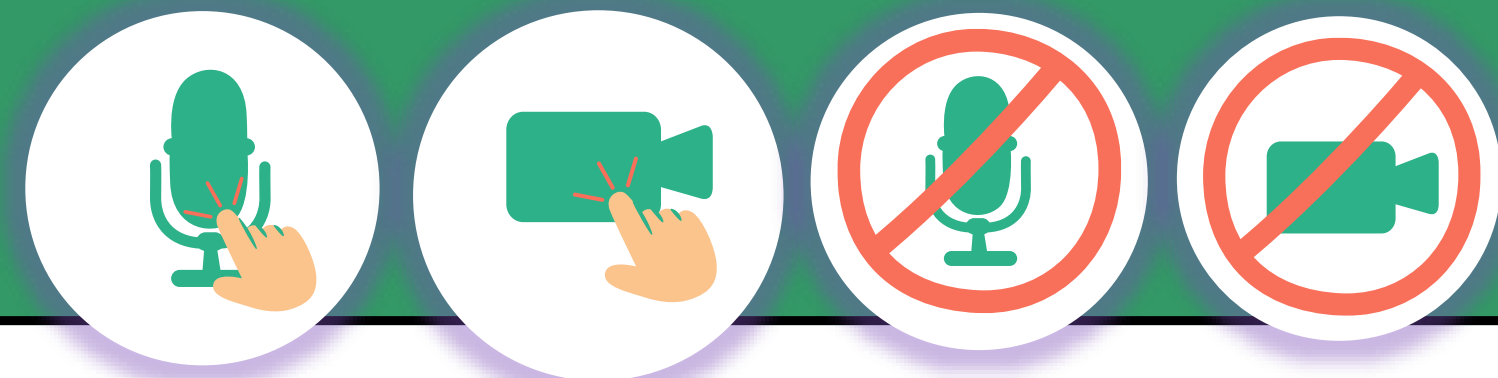
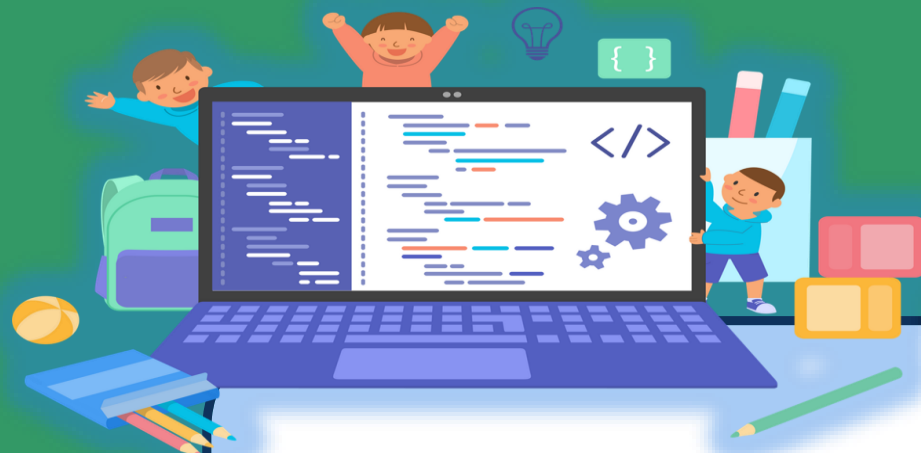
